

GARBAGE/RECYCLING COLLECTION CONTRACT 2021-2023

CONTRACT AWARDED NOVEMBER 12, 2020 TO RIDGE G & P SERVICES LTD. <u>CONTRACT TERM: JANUARY 5TH, 2021 - DECEMBER 31ST, 2023</u>

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. **Start Date:** The first collection will be on <u>Tuesday, January 5th, 2021</u> and every Tuesday thereafter will be our garbage day. In the case of bad weather, holidays, etc the garbage will be picked up the following day.
- 2. Garbage Collection: Domestic and Bulk Collection every week for Residential & Commercial Pickup with a Eight (8) bag limit per week. No Spring or Fall Cleanup.
- 3. Garbage Container: Garbage must be free of ice & snow and placed outside the road reservation.
- Garbage Disposal (Personal): Building/Renovation materials Etc, will be the responsibility of the homeowner and can be dropped of at the Harbour Grace Waste Facility on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12 Noon to 4:00pm and Saturdays 8:00 am to 11:30am and 12:30pm to 4:00pm.

- 5. **Recycling:** Recycling will be every second Tuesday starting January 5th, 2021. Information on recycling & scheduling can be found on the Town of Brigus website <u>www.brigus.net</u> or contact the Town Office at 709-528-4588.
- 6. Metals: In the case of Hot Water Boilers, Stoves, Fridges Etc, please contact the Town Office (528-4588) to arrange for pickup or you may dropped them of at French's in Bay Roberts.
- 7. **Route:** The route has not changed and will follow the same route as previous years. It is important that you have a **garbage container** and your garbage out the night before or early in the morning.
- 8. Bags: All garbage to be placed in proper Garbage Bags and not pup bags (i.e. grocery/shopping bags etc). If not placed in proper garbage bags, they will be left behind. Under Occupation Health & Safety, no bag is to exceed 18.14kg (40lb).
 Bags that are left behind at the curb that may be torn open will be the responsibility of the homeowner for clean up.
- **9. Grass/Ashes/Branches/Leaves**: These are not accepted and will not be picked up. These may be dropped of at the Towns pit on Englishtown Rd. West. At no time should any items other then those approved be dropped of at this site. Name/s of those caught or reported will be turned over to the RCMP.
